Food handler classes in Citronelle

The Mobile County Health Department will conduct food handler classes at Citronelle City Hall, 9135 S. Main St., on July 7 at 11 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.

The Health Department will issue a food handler card for a \$15 fee to each person completing a class, which lasts approximately one hour. Anyone wanting to take a class should arrive 15 minutes early to allow time for registration. No one will be admitted to a class after it has begun. Children under age 12 will not be allowed in the classroom.

The Health Department conducts food handler classes every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at 8:30 a.m., 10 a.m., 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m., and 3 p.m. in Building 6 at its downtown facility, 251 N. Bayou St. Classes are also available online at www.alabamafoodhandler.com. Anyone taking the online class must bring the certificate of course completion, a valid photo I.D. and \$15 to Building 6 in order to receive a food handler card.

Food handler cards must be renewed every two years. The renewal fee is \$15. To arrange a food handler class for a group of 15 or more, call 690-8116.
