GROUP A DISEASES/CONDITIONS-REPORT TO THE COUNTY (OR STATE) HEALTH DEPARTMENT BY TELEPHONE, FAX, OR IN PERSON WITHIN 24 HOURS OF DIAGNOSIS.

Anthrax, human	Pertussis
Botulism	Poliomyelitis, paralytic
Cholera	Rabies, human and animal
Diphtheria	Trichinosis
H. <i>Influenzae</i> , invasive diseases*	Tuberculosis
Hepatitis A	Typhoid fever
